

VBSE TOGETHER Instructions

(VBSE TOGETHER program available to buy at: <http://www.hcp.ehdef.com>)

Once VBSE TOGETHER has been downloaded, follow the prompts to install the program. When installation has been completed, enter your unique Serial Number to activate the program.

Once installed click the VBSE TOGETHER icon on your desktop to load the program.

ENTERING VIBRATIONAL BALANCING OR SANJEEVINI EASE PROGRAM

At VBSE TOGETHER program Opening Screen, click anywhere on either program to enter it.

PROGRAM SETUP OPTIONS

As VBSE TOGETHER setup is completed you will be prompted for your name. The setup program defaults to the name you use for Windows, but can be changed according to your preference. This name will be listed on printouts as the creator of the Combinations.

Vibrational Balancing and **Sanjeevini Ease** each have their individual program setup sections, which are very similar. Each allows you to:

1. Insert the title (name) of the Combinations creator (usually program owner).
2. Edit the instructions which print out with each Combination printed by the program.
3. Adjust screen colors to your own preferences.
4. Reset values to program defaults.

SETTING UP SANJEEVINI EASE SCROLLING PRAYERS

Under Setup Options in the **Sanjeevini Ease** program there is also an option to allow you to edit/add scrolling Prayers, Switchphrases, Chants and/or Mantras. The program comes preprogrammed with the two prayers at the Sanjeevini Foundation website (<http://www.saisanjeevini.org/frames.htm>). However, you can change those to your own preferences, and you can include additional Prayers, Meditations, Switchwords, Chants or Mantras. Up to 5 prayers can be programmed into **Sanjeevini Ease**.

To edit/add to Scrolling Prayers, while in the **Sanjeevini Ease** program:

1. Click on **Setup Options**.
2. Click on **Scrolling Prayer**.
3. Highlight line to be edited or added.
4. Click on **Edit**.
5. Insert text. (Note: No hard return can be inserted, and though all text must be added in one line, the line can be as long as desired.)
6. Tab out of text to save it.
7. Press [Insert] to tag lines to be added to the Scrolling Prayers while charging samples. (An X in the column to the left of prayer text signifies the text will be included in the Scrolling Prayers.)
8. Press [Delete] to tag lines not to be added to the Scrolling Prayers while charging samples. (No x in the column to the left of prayer text signifies it will not be included in the Scrolling Prayers.)
(Alternatively, double-click on a Prayer line to toggle the X (Prayer Scrolling) on and off.)

SWITCHING BETWEEN PROGRAMS

To switch between **Vibrational Balancing** and **Sanjeevini Ease**:

1. While in either program, click on **Switch** (on the menu at the top left on main screen).
2. You will be prompted to save Current Combination.
If the Combination has been previously saved, click No.
If the Combination had not yet been saved, click Yes to save it.

Or

1. While in either program, click on **Close**.
2. You will be prompted to save Current Combination.
If the Combination has been previously saved, click No.
If the Combination had not yet been saved, click Yes to save it.
3. You will then be returned to the VBSE TOGETHER interface program.
4. Click on the program you wish to enter or Quit to close the program.

CARD COMBINATIONS

To work with pre-defined **Vibrational Balancing** or **Sanjeevini** Combinations, select Files then Open to open a previously defined Combination (a list of over 200 Combinations in either program should come up for you to choose from). You can combine as many different **Vibrational Balancing** or **Sanjeevini** Combinations as you wish into one, and you can add individual cards from the Images List (VB) or the Body Parts and/or Disease (Sanjeevini) Lists.

Though VBSE TOGETHER does not allow you to inter-mix Combinations between **Vibrational Balancing** and **Sanjeevini**, you can charge a single sample with Combinations from both programs (one program and then the other).

OPEN COMBINATION

Open Combination is used to open any previously defined. This could be any of the Combinations that came with the program, or any Combination that you have created, or any Combination you have edited and saved.

Open Combination is the option you to access any Combination in either program.

To open a Combination:

1. Select **Files**
2. Select **Open Combination**
3. Select the Combination you wish to open.
(If there are already cards on the Charge List, you will be asked to confirm whether you wish to add the Combination you are opening to the current Charge List or to clear the current Charge List. If you choose not to combine with the current Charge List and not to clear the current Charge List, you will be returned to the current Charge List, with no changes being made.)

CREATING CHARGE LISTS

Create Charge Lists by retrieving Combinations, combining Combinations and/or selecting individual cards, etc.

For example, in creating a **Sanjeevini** Combination in **Sanjeevini Ease** for a broken left foot you may wish to combine SSC18 EMERGENCIES COMBINATION with the Body Parts cards such as BPS7 BONES, BPS11 CIRCULATORY SYSTEM, BPS27 LEG & FOOT, BPS33 MUSCLE, BPS55 BODY (LEFT SIDE) and Disease Cards such as DS71 INJURY, DS143 SAFE, DS174 OXYGENATION, DS181 SOIL REJUVENATION, etc., adding cards that seem relevant to the situation.

To create the above Combination for a broken left foot:

1. Click on **Files**.
2. Click on **Open**.
3. Retrieve SSC18 EMERGENCIES COMBINATION.
4. Click on Body Parts and begin to type a body part, then click on the desired card from the drop-down list, and repeat for each Body Part card desired, or
 - a. Click Pick List graphic for the Body Parts.
 - b. Click each Body Part to highlight parts to add in (a second click on a part deselects it).
 - c. Click **Add** to add all highlighted Body Parts to the Charge List.
5. Click on Disease and begin to type a disease, then click on the desired card from the drop-down list, and repeat for each Disease card desired, or
 - a. Click Pick List graphic for Disease.
 - b. Click each Disease to highlight diseases to add in (a second click on a part deselects it).
 - c. Click **Add** to add all highlighted Diseases to the Charge List.

Alternatively, for a broken left foot one may wish to combine SSC18 EMERGENCIES COMBINATION with the Bone Injuries Combination, then add the Body Parts Cards BPS27 LEG & FOOT, BPS55 BODY (LEFT SIDE).

To create the above Combination for a broken left foot:

1. Click on **Files**.
2. Click on **Open**.
3. Retrieve SSC18 EMERGENCIES COMBINATION.
4. Click on **Files**.
5. Click on **Open**.
6. Retrieve Bone Injuries.
7. When asked "Combine with Current Combination" click on Yes.
8. Click on Body Parts and begin to type a body part, then click on the desired card from the drop-down list, and repeat for each Body Part card desired, or
 - a. Click Pick List graphic for the Body Parts.
 - b. Click each Body Part to highlight parts to add in (a second click on a part deselects it).
 - c. Click **Add** to add all highlighted Body Parts to the Charge List.

9. Click on Disease and begin to type a disease, then click on the desired card from the drop-down list, and repeat for each Disease card desired, or
 - a. Click Pick List graphic for Disease.
 - b. Click each Disease to highlight diseases to add in (a second click on a part deselected it).
 - c. Click **Add** to add all highlighted Diseases to the Charge List.

Once a Charge List is built, to have it available for future reference and/or use, you may wish to Create a Combination (discussed later).

CLEAR CHARGE LIST

To Clear Charge List:

1. Click on Charge List title or press Ctrl-C while in the Charge List.
2. You will be prompted to Confirm Clear Charge List.
To empty the current Charge List, click Yes.
To return to the current Charge List click No (returns you to the Charge List).
3. You will be prompted to save Current Combination.
If the Combination has been previously saved, click No.
If the Combination had not yet been saved, click Yes to save it.

(Note: Clicking the X on the top right of the Windows bar will abort the current Charge List without saving it and return to the VBSE TOGETHER opening screen.)

CREATE A COMBINATION

Use Create Combination to name a new Combination you have built.

1. Select **Files**.
2. Select **Create Combination**.
3. Enter the name for your new Combination. (Create Combination adds tags with the Combination file name to the beginning and end of a Combination. Retrieve a Combination again after its creation to see the tag lines.)

Create new Combinations by:

1. Combining existing Combinations, or
2. By picking individual cards, or
3. By combining existing Combinations with additional cards.

To keep the folder with the standard Combinations that come with the program clean, you may wish to *save new Combinations into a separate directory*.

To Create a new folder for Combinations:

1. Select **Files**.
2. Select **Create Combination**
3. Select the New Folder icon at the right in the window, and name the folder.
4. Save the new Combinations in the new folder.

(This also makes it easy to tell the difference between the Combinations you have created and Combinations that came with the program. It will also help keep the main Combination folder clean. Naming newly created Combinations with the current date and a person's name or something relevant, makes it easy to find the Combination for future reference.)

Create Combination is used to create a new Combination.

Create Combination adds tag lines to the beginning and the end of the file list with the name given to the newly created Combination.

When you add additional cards to an existing Combination and wish to save the Combination under a new name, such as the name of a person and the date it was created, use the Create Combination option under Files.

SAVE COMBINATION

Use **Save Combination** to save a Combination that has already been created, but has been edited:

1. Select **File**.
2. Select **Save Combination**.
3. Enter file name (keep same name as previously used, and confirm replacement of previous file).

Save Combination does not add tags to the beginning and end of the Combination, as it presumes the Combination already has the tags in it (shows on screen in the listing of cards in the Combination).

Save Combination is used when you edit a previously created Combination and you do not wish to have additional tag lines with the Combination name added to the beginning and end of the file.

I rarely use the Save Combination option, but when I do, it is because I deleted a line or added a comment to a line and wish to save the file under the same Combination name it was previously saved, without having the program add new tag lines.

DELETE COMBINATION

Delete Combination is used to remove any Combination in a directory you no longer wish to keep.

Once a Combination is deleted it cannot be recovered. Be sure you wish to delete any Combination you select for deletion.

To delete a Combination:

1. Select **Files**.
2. Select **Delete Combination**.
3. Select Combination for Deletion. You will be asked to confirm deletion.

Caution: Once you confirm the deletion, the file can no longer be accessed.

COMBINATION CHARGE LIST OPTIONS

Several options are available for working within a Combination Charge List. While in the Charge List, right-click the mouse to show a list of available options:

Delete Marked: Ctrl-D (click on a line in a Combination to mark it)

Create/edit comments for current line: [Insert Key] (then [Tab] to save comments/changes)

Delete Listing: Ctrl-C (clears all cards listed in current Combination)

Clear Marked: Ctrl-S (clears all selected/marked items)

CHARGE SAMPLE

The **Charge Sample** option displays the individual cards on the screen for charging samples.

To charge samples:

1. Place material to be charged in front of the computer screen, within an inch or two of it.
2. Click **Start** to begin charging.
3. Click **Pause** to stop charging temporarily, if needed. Then click **Start** to continue from current position.
4. Once charge has completed, another sample of the same Combination can be charged by clicking **ReStart**.
5. Click **Close** in the top left corner of the Charge Screen to exit the Charge Screen once Charge is completed.

Water, Energy Circles (see <http://www.ec.ehdef.com>) and individual Vibrational Balancing Images (see Charging Images with Combinations document at <http://www.hc.ehdef.com> for more information) can be charged with Combinations. A glass container is preferred for charging water. However, any container will work. Water can be charged in a small vial and then later copied to a glass of water for drinking with either the Vibrational Balancing Replicate and Transmit or the Sanjeevini Multiplication and Broadcast card. These two cards can be used interchangeably with either **Vibrational Balancing** or **Sanjeevini** (or Combinations including both).

DIRECTLY CHARGING YOURSELF WITH A COMBINATION

To directly charge yourself with **Vibrational Balancing** and/or **Sanjeevini** card Combinations:

1. Open or Create a Combination.
2. Click on **Charge Sample**.
3. Click on **Start**.
4. Place 3 fingers from your left hand on the images (or within 1-2 inches in front of the image on the computer screen) while the images are displayed (or, if possible a specific part that needs healing – such as the right hand or elbow – can be placed on the images instead).

You may also benefit from just sitting in front of the computer screen while running a combination, without necessarily placing your hand on the image.

PRINTING COMBINATIONS

Create a Combination and save it before you print it, so that the printout has the name you have given the Combination on the printout. Printouts can be used for manual charging of samples (without the computer). Instructions for manually charging samples, as well as the Magnetic Neutralization and the Replicate and Transmit (VB) or Neutralization and Multiplication and Broadcast (Sanjeevini) cards are included in the printed Combinations.

To print the current Combination:

1. Click on **Print Sample** on the main screen.
2. Choose and configure printer as desired.
3. Click OK to print.

CREATING PDFS

PDFs can be created with VBSE TOGETHER. PDFs can be useful for sending to people without the program, to allow them to charge Combinations manually. One simple, easy to use, free PDF generator is the CutePDF software . CutePDF can be downloaded from:

Setting the default Windows printer as the PDF printer can make it quick and easy to create PDFs. Anytime you wish to create a PDF with a Combination just select **Print Sample** and name the file.

QUIT PROGRAM

To quit VBSE TOGETHER:

1. While in either program click **Quit**.
2. You will be prompted to save Current Combination.
If the Combination has been previously saved, click No.
If the Combination had not yet been saved, click Yes to save it.
3. You will then be asked to confirm Quit Programs.
Click Yes to exit VBSE TOGETHER.
Click No to return to the program.

Or from the VBSE TOGETHER program opening screen click **Quit**.
