

**Switchword: TAP**

Shunyam Nirav dropped TAP from his list of Switchwords. He dropped a number of Switchwords Mangan gave us, and he also added about 25 of his own. Why he dropped the ones he did, I do not know. I did not ask him and he did not tell me.

In my focus on Switchwords, I expanded the definition of TAP to "convert; adapt; renovate."

So, that all having been said, I would think that TAP would be useful for helping to get someone else to see things your way, or even to adjust your own perspective to being able to see things differently and change yourself according to what you are experiencing.

Perhaps that is why EFT tapping is so powerful, it "taps" into TAP (the power of a Switchword can be tapped into by saying the Switchword, or by doing the action that the Switchword encompasses).

When you TAP on something you are changing its vibration.

A few TAP Switchphrases:

TAP-ON-LOVE (adapt, build, generate, radiate and experience love and acceptance)

TAP-WITH-LOVE (adapt to harmonize with love and acceptance)

DIVINE-TAP (increase personal ability to adapt)

TAP-AROUND-LOVE (adapt to a wider perspective on love and acceptance)

TAP-DANCE (convert to feeling joy)

CONSIDER-TAP (fix things by adapting to them)
